Trafford Community Response

Trafford Crisis Response (Admission avoidance)

Provides a rapid (2hr) response and assessment service at home for people in urgent need of health and social care intervention at home. Up to 48hrs support. Patients over 18 with Trafford GP. Referrals not condition specific. More information at [Trafford Crisis Response](#).

Referrals taken from GPs, community health, social care, NWS and A&E to prevent avoidable admission. 7 days a week, 8am - 9.30pm. Last referral 8pm.

Trafford Community IV

Provides IV therapy & sub cut fluids in patients own home or a community clinic instead of hospital.

Signposting and support for patients who are socially isolated/lonely, at risk of re-admission, causing you worry.

Trafford Discharge to Assess (D2A) (Health support for Pathway 1)

Expedites health Pathway 1 discharge for Trafford residents by carrying out therapy assessments at home rather than in a hospital bed. Provide care while assessment is completed. Referrals made via hospital discharge/therapy teams. More information at [Trafford D2A](#).

Discharge to Assess Beds

A number of beds within private residential & nursing homes and nine beds within Ascot House. The beds are managed and allocated by the Urgent Care Control Room.

Equipment - One Stop Resource Centre

Joint venture between Manchester University NHS Foundation Trust (MFT) and Trafford Council. The service provides community equipment and adaptation services for people living in Trafford, who may need assistance with daily living. Hospital therapists, Trafford liaison nurses & Trafford clinicians are able to order equipment directly via a web-based system.

Manchester Residents

Local Authority can be identified by asking the patient who they pay their council tax to. If this is the City of Manchester then they are a Manchester resident. If they pay their council tax to another borough in Greater Manchester then they are not a Manchester resident.
